## Differentiation in the 'Real World': Effective Planning and Teaching for Diverse Secondary Students MONDAY 29 MAY 2017

The workshop will explore how to enrich learning experiences for all children, including those who have a disability, developmental delay and those who are experiencing difficulties in learning. It is interactive with a practical focus and will include:

- Developing an understanding of what it really means to differentiate effectively to address student diversity in mainstream secondary classrooms with competing demands
- Understanding differentiation as an overall approach to teaching and learning, that is grounded in a set of core, underlying principles
- Identifying differentiation strategies and practices that are evidence-informed, and that move beyond fun activities that do little to enhance student learning
- Building a repertoire of both "low-prep" and "high-prep" strategies for differentiation over time
- Considering approaches to grouping, assessment and classroom leadership and management that create a learning environment likely to support effective differentiation
- Reflecting on the development of professional skills and competencies related to differentiation along a continuum of expertise, in line with the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers.
